1. Men and women program

2. General terms and conditions

- The provisional schedule will be published no later than June 15, 2025 at <https://www.atletiek.nl/toernooien/onk-para-atletiek/>.
- The participant lists, starting and follow-up heights for high jump and the final schedule will be published no later than June 28 at <https://www.atletiek.nl/toernooien/onk-para-atletiek/>.
- An event will take place once an admitted athlete has reported and appeared at the start via the call room.

3. Registration conditions

- The athlete, with Dutch nationality, have completed the [E-learning Bronze and Silver of the Doping Authority](#) before the registration closes.
- Registration closes on June 22, 2025 at 11:59 PM;
- The athlete will be excluded from participation if the registration fee has not been paid at the closing date of registration and/or (for athletes with Dutch nationality) the E-learning modules have not been completed.
- The performance with which the entry is submitted must have been achieved at an officially recognized competition and preferably in the period from March 1, 2024 to June 22, 2025.
- A performance up to 800 m based on manual times will not be accepted.
- A performance with an unacceptable wind advantage ($> +2.0$ m/s) or where the wind measurement is missing in the case of an outdoor performance will not be accepted;
- A performance must be verifiable via an [online result of the relevant competition](#), a direct link to

the performance must be added upon registration.

- h) The class must be specified upon registration;
- i) Each athlete must have a national and/or international classification before the closing of registration. Read the classification policy of the Dutch Athletics Federation [here](#);
- j) A performance entered must have been achieved in accordance with the regulations for the class entered with regard to specifications of the component concerned.

4. Placement

- a) The athletes whose registration complies with the registration requirements will be placed.

5. Unsubscribe/Do not participate

- a) The placed athlete must report on the day of the competition, before the deadline for the event in question, with the national qualification pass showing the correct class. See also the information bulletin;
- b) Cancellation must be made to the competition secretary or the TIC before the closing time;
- c) If the athlete does not cancel in time (i.e. before the deadline for the event in question), the athlete risks an administrative fine of €25.00 according to the [General Regulations](#) of the Dutch Athletics Federation.

6. Championship title(s) and NK medals

- a) For each category, regardless of class and nationality, there are medals available for the 1st , 2nd and /or 3rd athlete in the respective event. The respective gold, silver and bronze medal is awarded based on a percentage (%) of the world record in the underlying class;
- b) When classes are combined on the Paralympic program, this also applies to the National Championships. If there are at least five participants in a [Paralympic class](#) , medals are made available for this class. The best performance per class counts for the final result of the championship.

7. Replacement provisions

The most recent competition regulations, <https://www.atletiekunie.nl/kenniscentrum/wedstrijdorganisatie/reglementen/>, of the Dutch Athletics Federation are in effect. Replacement provisions are:

- a) In case of more heats, these are divided by time regardless of the class with a division into ambulant or wheelchair and men or women.
